T3 Technologies is a privately held firm based in Tampa, Florida. The company was launched in 1992 and has been involved with mainframe hardware and services since its inception.

T3 began marketing its *tServer* line of mainframe-compatible systems in 2000. Developed specifically for smaller-sized users that IBM offerings no longer suited, the tServer became the leading small mainframe in the world, with over 600 units installed in 28 countries.

In 2006, T3 released its *Liberty* family of mainframes, which accommodated larger users than the tServer and added extended functionality. Liberty systems competed directly with much of IBM's mid-sized product line.
